# Need for SLS in the time frame of February 2002

- Consensus was yes to inter-domain negotiation
  - Provider to provider interfaces (eg. operators peering agreements)
  - Provider to customer interfaces (eg. automated VPN self-provisioning)
  - Leave intra-domain standardization for later
